Irish Nursing Home Job Vacancies

There are in excess of 300 nursing job vacancies in the private nursing home sector in Ireland. We are currently working with Nursing Homes Ireland as well as working with a number of nursing homes directly. Nursing Homes Ireland is the body that all private nursing homes are affiliated to. It is highly regulated by the Health Information and Quality Authority of Ireland.

Candidates can choose lively cities or beautiful rural locations. The cost of living and rent is cheaper outside of large urban areas.

Nursing Homes require fully qualified nurses to do all the traditional roles of a nurse from caring to phlebotomy. The role will include:
